Luke 8:26-39: And when Jesus stepped out [of His boat] on the land, there met Him a certain man from the city who had demons for a long time. And he wore no clothes, nor did he live in a house but in the tombs. When he saw Jesus, he cried out, fell down before Him, and with a loud voice said, "What have I to do with You, Jesus, Son of the Most High God? I beg You, do not torment me!" For He had commanded the unclean spirit to come out of the man. ... Then the whole multitude of the surrounding region ... asked Him to depart from them, for they were seized with great fear.
