(Paschal Hypakoe): Before the dawn Mary and the women came and found the stone rolled away from the tomb. They heard the angelic voice: Why do you seek among the dead as a man the One Who is everlasting Light? Behold the clothes in the grave and proclaim to the world: The Lord is risen, He has slain death as He is the Son of God, saving the race of man.

Now and ever, and unto ages of ages. Amen.

(Paschal Kontakion): Thou didst descend into the tomb. O Immortal. Thou didst destroy the power of death. In victory didst Thou arise, O Christ God, proclaiming rejoice to the myrrh-bearing women, granting peace to Thine apostles, and bestowing resurrection on the fallen.
