The following Troparia and Kontakia are sung after the Little Entrance:

(<u>Resurrectional Troparion--Tone 8</u>) Thou didst descend from on high O Merciful One! Thou didst endure the three-day burial to free us from our sufferings! Oh Lord, our Life and resurrection, glory to Thee!

(<u>All Saints Troparion</u>) As with fine porphyry and royal purple, Thy Church has been adorned with Thy martyrs' blood shed throughout all the world. She cries to Thee, O Christ God: Send down Thy bounties on Thy people; grant peace to Thy habitation, and great mercy to our souls.

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit: (**Resurrectional Kontakion--Tone 8**) By rising from the tomb Thou didst raise the dead and resurrect Adam. Eve exults in Thy resurrection, and the world celebrates Thy rising from the dead, O greatly Merciful One.

Now and every and unto ages of ages. Amen. (<u>Steadfast Protectress Kontakion--Tone 6</u>) Steadfast Protectress of Christians, Constant Advocate before the Creator; despise not the entreating cries of us sinners, but in your goodness come speedily to help us who call on you in faith. Hasten to hear our petition and to intercede for us, O THEOTOKOS, for you always protect those who honor you!
