A WARM WELCOME TO OUR VISITORS... We are pleased to have visitors worship with us, and we pray that you will be blessed through your experience in our services. In the Orthodox Church, the reception of Holy Communion is a mark of membership in the Church. Only those who have been united to the Orthodox Church through Baptism and Chrismation, having prepared themselves through Confession, prayer and fasting, are permitted to partake of Holy Communion. However, all are welcome to share in the blessed bread at the end of the service.

The following Troparia and Kontakia are sung after the Little Entrance:

(Resurrectional Troparion--Tone 3): Let the heavens rejoice! Let the earth be glad! For the Lord has shown strength with His arm! He has trampled down death by death! He has become the First-born of the dead! He has delivered us from the depths of hell and has granted the world great mercy.

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit. (The Paralytic--Kontakion--Tone 3): By Your divine intercession, O Lord, as You raised up the paralytic of old, so raise up my soul, paralyzed by sins and thoughtless acts; so that being saved I may sing to You: Glory to Your power, O compassionate Christ!

Now and ever and unto ages of ages. Amen. (Paschal Kontakion--Carpatho-Russian Chant): Thou didst descend into the tomb, O Immortal. Thou didst destroy the power of death. In victory didst Thou arise, O Christ God, proclaiming "Rejoice" to the myrrh-bearing women, granting peace to Thine apostles, and bestowing resurrection on the fallen!

We pray to the Lord in His great mercy to visit and heal our brothers and sisters who are in need: Tanya Carrelle recovering from surgery; newly born Rezanka grandson Kody and mother Natasha.
