The following Troparia and Kontakia are sung after the Little Entrance:

(**Resurrectional Troparion--Tone 4**): When the women disciples of the Lord learned from the angel the joyous message of Thy resurrection; they cast away the ancestral curse and elatedly told the apostles: Death is overthrown, Christ God is risen granting the world great mercy.

(Midfeast Troparion--Tone 8): In the middle of the Feast, O Savior, fill my thirsting soul with the waters of godliness, as Thou didst cry to all: If anyone thirst let him come to me and drink! O Chirst God, Fountain of our life, glory to Thee.

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit. (Samaritan Woman Troparion--Tone 8): The Samaritan Woman came to the well in faith; she saw You the Water of Wisdom, and drank abundantly! She inherited the Kingdom on high, and is ever glorified.

Now and ever and unto ages of ages. Amen. (Midfeast Kontakion—Tone 4): Christ God, the Creator and Master of all cried to all in the midst of the Feast of the law: Come and draw the water of immortality! We fall down before Thee and faithfully cry: Grant us Thy bounties, for Thou art the Fountain of our life.

We pray to the Lord in His great mercy to visit and heal our brothers and sisters who are in need: Tanya Carrelle recovering from surgery; newly born Rezanka grandson Kody and mother Natasha.
