Saints of the Day: Relics of Ven. Seraphim of Sarov

A WARM WELCOME TO OUR VISITORS... We are pleased to have visitors worship with us, and we pray that you will be blessed through your experience in our services. In the Orthodox Church, the reception of Holy Communion is a mark of membership in the Church. Only those who have been united to the Orthodox Church through Baptism and Chrismation, having prepared themselves through Confession, prayer and fasting, are permitted to partake of Holy Communion. However, all are welcome to share in the blessed bread at the end of the service.

The following Troparia and Kontakia are sung after the Little Entrance:

(Resurrectional Troparion—Tone 6): The angelic powers were at Thy Tomb, the guards became as dead men. Mary stood by Thy grave seeking Thy most pure Body. Thou didst capture hell, not being tempted by it. Thou didst come to the Virgin granting life. O Lord Who didst arise from the dead: Glory to Thee!

(Uncovering of the Relics of St. Seraphim of Sarov [1903] Troparion—Tone 4): You loved Christ from your youth, O blessed one, and longing to work for Him alone you struggled in the wilderness in constant prayer and labor. With penitent heart and great love for Christ you were favored by the Mother of God. Therefore we cry to you: "Save us by your prayers, venerable Seraphim, our father." (Resurrectional Kontakion—Tone 6): When Christ God the Giver of Life, raised all of the dead from the valleys of misery with His mighty hand, He bestowed resurrection on the human race; He is the Savior of all, the Resurrection, the Life, and the God of all!

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit; (Uncovering of the Relics of St. Seraphim or Sarov Kontakion—Tone 2): Forsaking the beauty as well as the corruption of this world, you settled in the monastery of Sarov, O Saint. There you lived an angelic life, becoming for many the way to salvation. Therefore, Christ has glorified you, Father Seraphim, enriching you with abundant healing and miracles. So we cry to you: "Save us by your prayers, venerable Seraphim, our father."

Now and ever, and unto ages of ages. Amen. (<u>Steadfast Protectress—Tone 6</u>): Steadfast Protectress of Christians, Constant Advocate before the Creator; despise not the entreating cries of us sinners, but in your goodness come speedily to help us who call on you in faith. Hasten to hear our petition and to intercede for us, O Theotokos, for you always protect those who honor you!
