

(Resurrectional Troparion--Tone 6) The angelic powers were at Thy tomb; the guards became as dead men. Mary stood by Thy grave, seeking Thy Most Pure Body. Thou didst capture hell not being tempted by it. Thou didst come to the Virgin granting life. O Lord Who didst rise from the dead, glory to Thee!

(Synaxis of the Archangel Michael and the Other Bodiless Powers Troparion--Tone 4) Commanders of the heavenly hosts, we who are unworthy beseech you, by your prayers encompass us beneath the wings of your immaterial glory, and faithfully preserve us who fall down and cry to you: "Deliver us from all harm, for you are the commanders of the powers on high!"

(Resurrectional Kontakion--Tone 6) When Christ God the Giver of Life, raised all of the dead from the valleys of misery with His mighty hand, He bestowed resurrection on the human race. He is the savior of all, the Resurrection, the Life and the God of all.
