(Resurrectional Troparion--Tone 3) Let the heavens rejoice! Let the earth be glad! For the Lord has shown strength with His Arm! He has trampled down death by death! He has become the firstborn of the dead! He has delivered us from the depths of hell and has granted the world great mercy.

(Fathers of the 1st Six Ecumenical Councils Troparion--Tone 8) Thou art most glorious, O Christ our God! Thou hast established the Holy Fathers as lights on the earth. Through them Thou hast guided us to the true Faith. O greatly compassionate One, glory to Thee!
