(Resurrectional Troparion--Tone 1) When the stone had been sealed by the Jews, while the soldiers were guarding Thy most pure body, Thou didst rise on the third day, O Savior, granting life to the world. The powers of heaven therefore cried to Thee, O Giver of Life: "Glory to Thy Resurrection, O Christ! Glory to Thy Kingdom! // Glory to Thy dispensation, O Lover of mankind!"

(All Saints Troparion--Trinity/St. Sergius Lavra Chant) As with fine porphyry and royal purple, Thy Church has been adorned with Thy martyrs' blood shed throughout all the world. She cries to Thee, O Christ God: "Send down Thy bounty on Thy people, grant peace to Thy habitation, and great mercy to our souls." (Venerable Job of Pochaev Troparion--Tone 4) Having acquired the patience of your Forefather, and having resembled the Baptist in abstinence, you shared the divine zeal of both and were ma worthy to receive their names. You were a fearless preacher of the True Faith; in this way you brought a multitude of monastics to Christ. You strengthened all people in Orthodoxy, Job, our venerable father; // pray that our souls may be saved!

GLORY TO THE FATHER, AND TO THE SON, AND TO THE HOLY SPIRIT: (Venerable Job of Pochaev Kontakion--Tone 4) You were a pillar of the True Faith; a zealot of the commandments of the Gospel; a denouncer of pride, and a defender and teacher of the humble. Therefore, those who honor you pray for the remission of their sins, and that this, your holy habitation, be kept safe from all harm, // Job, our father, who resembled the long-suffering Patriarch of old.

NOW AND EVER, AND UNTO AGES OF AGES. AMEN. (Resurrectional Kontakion--Tone 1)

As God, Thou didst rise from the tomb in glory, raising the world with Thyself. Human nature praises Thee as God, for death has vanished. Adam exults, O Master! Eve rejoices, for she is freed from bondage and cries to Thee: // "Thou art the Giver of Resurrection to all, O Christ!"
