(Resurrectional Troparion--Tone 4) When the women disciples of the Lord learned from the angel the joyous message of Thy resurrection; they cast away the ancestral curse and elatedly told the apostles: Death is overthrown; Christ God is risen granting the world great mercy.

(Epiphany Troparion--Tone 1) When Thou, O Lord, wast baptized in the Jordan, the worship of the Trinity was made manifest! For the Voice of the Father bare witness to Thee, and called Thee His beloved Son! And the Spirit in the form of a dove confirmed the truthfulness of His word. O Christ our God, who hast revealed Thyself and has enlightened the world, glory to Thee!

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit: (Resurrectional Kontakion--Tone 4) My Savior and Redeemer, as God rose from the tomb and delivered the earth-born from their chains. (Epiphany Kontakion--Tone 4) Today Thou hast shown forth to the world, O Lord, and the light of Thy countenance has been marked on us. Knowing Thee, we sing Thy praises; Thou hast come and revealed Thyself, O Light unapproachable.
