(Resurrectional Troparion--Tone 7) By Thy Cross Thou didst destroy death. To the thief Thou didst open Paradise. For the Myrrh bearers Thou didst change weeping into joy, and Thou didst command Thy disciples, O Christ God, to proclaim that Thou art risen, granting the world great mercy.

(All Saints Troparion--Trinity/St. Sergius Lavra Chant) As with fine porphyry and royal purple, Thy Church has been adorned with Thy martyrs' blood shed throughout all the world. She cries out to thee, O Christ God: "Send down Thy bounties on Thy people, grant peace to Thy habitation, and great mercy to our souls."

(Hieromartyr Ignatius the God-bearer Troparion--Tone 4) By sharing in the ways of the Apostles, you became a successor to their throne. Through the practice of virtue you found the way to divine contemplation, O inspired one of God; by teaching the world of truth without error, you defended the Faith, even to the shedding of your blood. Hieromartyr Ignatius, entreat God to save our souls.

(Resurrectional Kontakion--Tone 7) The dominion of death can no longer hold men captive, for Christ descended, shattering and destroying its powers. Hell is bound, while the Prophets rejoice and cry: "The Savior has come to those in faith; enter, you faithful, into the Resurrection!"

the God-bearer Kontakion--Tone 4) Today you rose from the east, enlightening all of creation with your teachings, and you are crowned with martyrdom, God-bearing Ignatius.

NOW AND EVER, AND UNTO AGES OF AGES. AMEN. (Steadfast Protectress Kontakion--Tone 6) Steadfast Protectress of Christians, Constant Advocate before the Creator; despise not the entreating cries of us sinners, but in your goodness come speedily to help us who call on you in
