(Resurrectional Troparion--Tone 5) Let us the faithful praise and worship the Word, Co-Eternal with the Father and the Spirit, born for our salvation from the Virgin; for He willed to lifted up on the Cross in the flesh, to endure death, and to raise the dead by His glorious Resurrection.

(All Saints Troparion--Trinity-St. Sergius Lavra Chant) As with fine porphyry and royal purple, Thy Church has been adorned with Thy martyrs' blood shed throughout all the world. She cries to Thee, O Christ God: "Send down Thy bounties on Thy people; grant peace to Thy habitation, and great mercy to our souls."

(St. Gregory Palamas, Archbishop of Thessalonica Troparion--Tone 8) O light of Orthodoxy, teacher of the Church, its confirmation; O ideal of monks and invincible champion of theologians; O wonder-working Gregory, glory of Thessalonica and preacher of grace, always intercede before the Lord that our souls may be saved.

GLORY TO THE FATHER, AND TO THE SON, AND TO THE HOLY SPIRIT: (Triodion [Second Sunday of Great Lent] Troparion--Tone 4) Now is the time for action! Judgment is at the doors! So let us rise and fast, offering alms with tears of compunction and crying: "Our sins are more in number than the sands of the sea; but forgive us, O Master of All, so that we may receive the incorruptible crowns."

NOW AND EVER, AND UNTO AGES OF AGES. AMEN. (St. Gregory Palamas Kontakion [Carpatho-Russian Chant] --Tone 8) Holy and divine instrument of wisdom, joyful trumpet of theology, together we sing your praises, O God-inspired Gregory. Since you now stand before the Original Mind, guide our minds to Him, O Father, so that we may sing to you: "Rejoice, preacher of grace."
