**(Resurrectional Troparion--Tone 7)** By Thy Cross, Thou didst destroy death! To the thief, Thou didst open paradise! For the myrrh-bearers, Thou didst change weeping into joy! And Thou didst command Thy disciples, O Christ God, to proclaim that Thou art risen, granting the world great mercy.

**(Annunciation Troparion--Tone 4)** Today is the beginning of our salvation, the revelation of the eternal mystery! The Son of God becomes the Son of the Virgin as Gabriel announces the coming of Grace. Together with him let us cry to the Theotokos: "Rejoice, O Full of Grace, the Lord is with you."

**(Synaxis of the Archangel Gabriel Troparion--Tone 4)** Gabriel, commander of the heavenly hosts, we who are unworthy beseech you, by your prayers encompass us beneath the wings of your immaterial glory, and faithfully preserve us who fall down and cry to you: "Deliver us from all harm, for you are the commander of the powers on high!"

**GLORY TO THE FATHER, AND TO THE SON, AND TO THE HOLY SPIRIT: (Synaxis of the Archangel Gabriel Kontakion--Tone 8)** Supreme commander Gabriel, you are the glorious intercessor and servant before the all-radiant, worthy, all-powerful, infinite and awesome Trinity. Ever pray now that we may be delivered from all tribulations and torments, so that we may cry out to you: "Rejoice, protection of your servants!"

**NOW AND EVER, AND UNTO AGES OF AGES. AMEN. (Annunciation Kontakion--Tone 8)** O victorious leader of triumphant hosts! We your servants, delivered from evil sing our grateful thanks to you, O Theotokos! As you possess invincible might set us free from every calamity so that we may sing: Rejoice, O unwedded Bride!
