GLORY TO THE FATHER, AND TO THE SON, AND TO THE HOLY SPIRIT: (Hypakoe--Tone 8)

BEFORE THE DAWN MARY AND THE WOMEN CAME AND FOUND THE STONE ROLLED AWAY FROM THE TOMB. THEY HEARD THE ANGELIC VOICE: "WHY DO YOU SEEK AMONG THE DEAD AS A MAN THE ONE WHO IS EVER-LASTING LIGHT? BEHOLD THE CLOTHES IN THE GRAVE; GO AND PROCLAIM TO THE WORLD: THE LORD IS RISEN; HE HAS SLAIN DEATH AS HE IS THE SON OF GOD, SAVING THE RACE OF MAN.

NOW AND EVER, AND UNTO AGES OF AGES. AMEN. (Paschal Kontakion) THOU DIDST DESCEND INTO THE TOMB, O IMMORTAL. THOU DIDST DESTROY THE POWER OF DEATH.
